

Continuing Education Guidelines

German Society for Fertility Counselling e.V.

The following criteria represent the Continuing Education Guidelines for all counsellors accredited by BKiD. The guidelines are based on a system of points and they are divided into three areas. In each area, counsellors must achieve the indicated minimum number of points. Within three years, counsellors must achieve 100 points in order to receive or continue their accreditation by BKiD. Accreditation is based on voluntary commitment. BKiD reserves the right to verify proof of evidence. Evidence of commitment to the Continuing Education Guidelines must be submitted to the Continuing Education Committee; this is composed of three members elected for two years during the Annual Meeting of BKiD.

1. Participation in conferences, workshops etc.

(a minimum of 30 points)

BKiD conference 15
(Attendance of at least one [BKiD conference](#) within three years is required)

Other conferences with contents in accordance with the BKiD preamble (conferences etc. on psychosocial health, reproductive health, naturopathy, environmental health, ethics, theology) 5

Attendance of an infertility training course (per 7 hours/day) 10

2. Counselling practice

(a minimum of 40 points)

Infertility counselling (50 sessions within three years are the equivalent of 60 points, please calculate accordingly) 60

Carrying out an infertility training course (per 7 hours/day) 10

3. Reflexive practice

(a minimum of 30 points)

Supervision, peer-supervision, self-awareness groups etc. (per 10 hours) 10

Visit/Internship of an infertility clinic or infertility counselling agency 5

Presentations, publications, public awareness work 5
